Suggested Module Pairings:

Smash Play + Diversity & Inclusion junior-tamariki

For any new cricket deliverers, or existing deliverers looking to upskill, completing the Smash Play junior-tamariki Introduction and the Diversity and Inclusion module is a good starting point.

Smash Play junior-tamariki is a cricket programme for juniors (5-12 year olds) introduced by NZC for the 2022/23 season. With Smash Play junior-tamariki being delivered throughout the country, understanding what it is and what it looks like is important for any deliverer.

The Diversity and Inclusion module focuses on making cricket as accessible as possible and providing resources to help with this accessible delivery.
