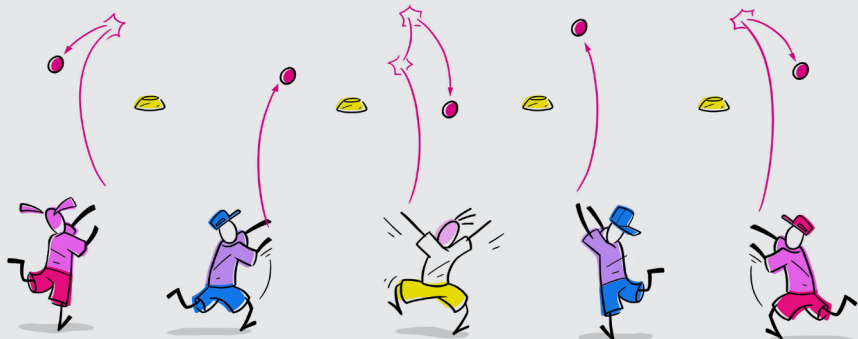
### WHAT OTHER SKILLS COULD BE INVOLVED

### THINK QUICK — WHAT TO LOOK OUT FOR

- Encourage Smashies to explore the wrist and finger movements required to spin the ball.

## SET UP



## LET'S PLAY

- Smashies to play as individuals.
- Set up a line of cones, with Smashies facing the same direction.
- Each Smashie has a large ball.
- Smashies should use two hands and attempt to spin / rotate the ball.
- Smashies score a point by throwing their ball over the line of cones and trying to make it bounce back towards them. If it spins back past the cones, they score a point.

### EQUIPMENT



Cones, Balls (Small or Large).

### TIME



5 minutes on activity.

Small or large groups, or try it at home with someone.

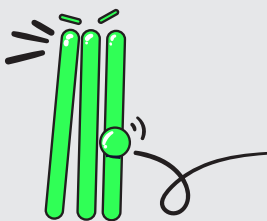

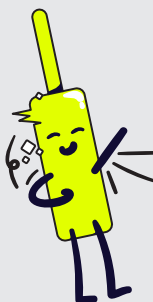
## HONESTY PONO

# MIX IT UP

- ⊖ Smashies throw the ball in the air to themselves and catch it, trying to spin the ball in the air.
- ⊕ Smashies to play 1 v 1 with a line of cones. Points are scored by spinning the ball from one side to the other. Points are added together or first to 10 wins.

# SMASH IT UP



Mission – If the Smashie successfully spins the ball backwards three times in a row they have an **Energy Boost** of an additional point.



Boss Battle – Smashies vs Activator / Coach / Whānau / Teacher - time yourself and see who can throw, spin and catch the most.



Arena Mode – Introduce a hoop on the ground, throw the ball into the hoop and make it bounce out of it.

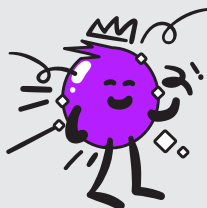
