

Governance 101 for Directors in Cricket – How to Access

This online course allows those leading and overseeing cricket to develop their skills from the comfort of their own home, at a time that suits them.

It can be completed within two to six hours depending on how new this information is to you and how indepth you choose to focus and apply the learning.

- For some, it's simply an overview and refresher around good governance.
- For others, it may present new knowledge and can help you systematically consider how well you
 and your Board are fulfilling various aspects of your governance role and requirements.

There are Partnership Agreement targets for all NZC, Major Association and District Association Board members to complete this course. With new board members encouraged to do so within six months of their appointment.

Get a Sport Tutor Login

Go to www.sporttutor.nz and click on the 'Sign-up' tab.

Follow the Sign-up instructions to get yourself a Sport Tutor Username and Password. Make a note of these somewhere so you can remember them each time you log in.

If you go back in after a period of time and have forgotten your password you'll see an option there for 'Forgot Your Password' which you can click on and the system will send you a new one.


Log In to Sport Tutor

Add Governance 101 for Directors in Cricket into your 'My Learning'


Please make sure you **choose the 'Cricket' course**, rather than the 'Generic' course. This allows us to add customized content and forums relevant to cricket governance.

Description

In this programme you'll learn the fundamentals of governance, which can be applied to any organisation and are particularly relevant to not-for-profits. This programme is based on the sport and recreation governance framework and uses the resources available on the Sport New Zealand website.

There's more than one right way to govern, so these modules focus on the key principles that are applicable no matter which context or governance model you are working within.

Course includes

- Module 1: The role of the director.
- Module 2: The board's strategic role.
- Module 3: Recruiting and inducting for the board.
- Module 4: How to prepare for and participate in a board meeting.
- Module 5: Board accountability, ethics and integrity
- Module 6: Get resources, tools and advice to help you put better governance into practice.
- Module 7: Short learning check to confirm you've understood critical learnings from the programme.




Once enrolled you'll have access to the course for ongoing use in your 'My Learning' space for 12 months.



- Work your way through the 7 modules, enjoying the short videos and practical resources

- Every time you return to the course you pick up where you left off. Just 'Log-in', click on 'My Learning' and select the 'Gov 101 for Cricket' course and you'll get straight back into it

How can you see what modules you've done and what's left to do?

Click on the course to be taken into the main menu with the various modules that are part of the course.



Green ticks = completed modules, Orange = started but not finished, White = not started

- Click on the modules that are incomplete (orange or white) and you will be taken into the module
- Work your way through the module completing each activity, watching each video etc until you reach the
 end
- When you get to the end of that module click the <<Back logo at the top left of the page
- This will take you back to the menu page where you should now have a Green Tick for the module you've just completed
- Follow that process for each module that you haven't done, finishing up with the test, which you must pass
 to complete the course
